



Tree Walk at The Evergreens Cemetery Saturday November 25, 2023

Join Trees New York's Arborist, Sam Bishop, for a free tree walk at the historic Evergreens Cemetery in Brooklyn and learn about their trees. With more than 3,000 trees, and winding tree lined roadways, originally planned in 1849 by noted landscape architect A.J. Downing, the Evergreens is accredited as a Level II Arboretum.

We will look at common and some less common trees in the cemetery's 225 acres, discuss the things that make them unique, and how they improve our environment.
